The 4th Annual Lady Cat Showdown

A chance to identify the strongest feeder program in Northern Illinois.

Sunday, January 13th 2008 at Libertyville High School

We are inviting programs to participate in this one-day tournament. One of our program's key values is that all teams, from fifth thru eighth grade, need to support and encourage one another. This tournament is designed to reinforce this value.

We are attempting to get no more than two programs from each of the NIGFBA divisions to compete. Each program must enter a team in the 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th grade divisions. Brackets will be set up so that every team will play three games. The first two games will be against non-conference opponents. Game format is 2 - 20 minute halves with running clock except for the last 2 minutes.

In addition to awards at the individual grade level – we will also be presenting the “Lady Cats Showdown” traveling trophy for the Program with the best overall finish. The winning program will have their program's name inscribed on the trophy with the year they won the tournament. This will give the winning program an automatic invite to next year's “Showdown” to defend their title. Barrington was last year's winning program and we will look forward to seeing if they will return to defend their title. We hope that other previous winners, Lake Forest and Bartlett also return to try and reclaim the crown.

This will be calculated by adding the “placing” of all four of your program's teams together. The lowest total score wins. In this format – every game counts towards this award. We are hoping this award encourages all of the teams to support and encourage their teammates at other age groups during the course of the day.

Games will begin Sunday at 8AM and the last game is scheduled to start at 7PM.

Tournament Fee is \$900 (\$225 per team) with 3 games guaranteed at each grade level.

There will also be concessions, raffle, silent auction, and apparel sales. Also, several TV's available to watch NFL football playoffs....in case the Bears make it again!

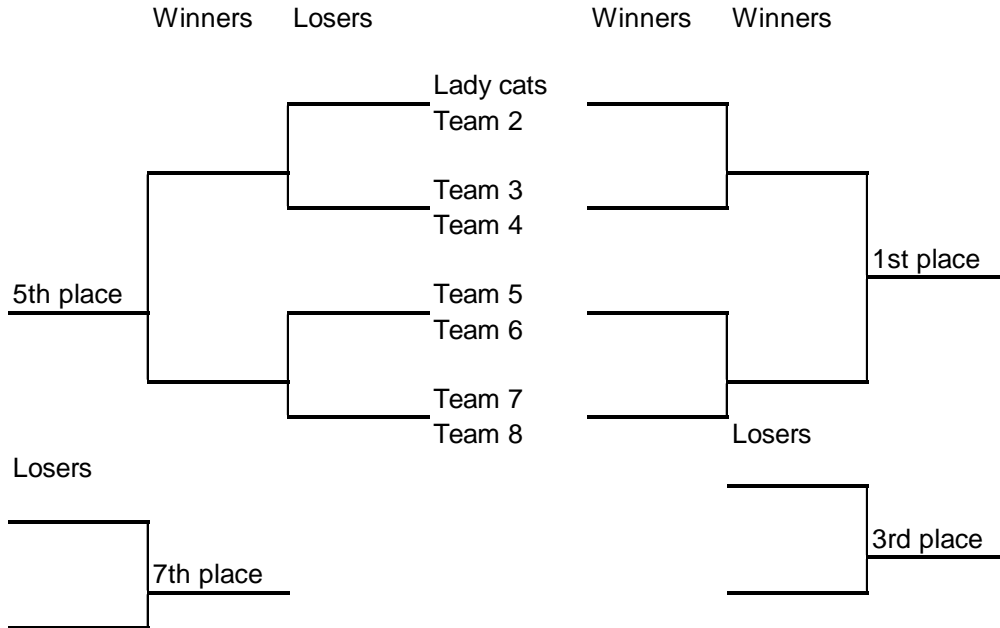
This is being done on a first come first serve basis. Monies must be in by December 1st to hold your spot. At that time, we will go to the next program in order of receipt of RSVP and payment.
