Tournament Rules

IHSA rules will apply with the following exceptions:

1. Games will consist of two eighteen-minute halves with a running clock except for the last 2 minutes of each half.
2. Any team not ready to play five minutes after their scheduled game time will forfeit that game. Teams will be excused if they are completing a game on another court and will be allowed ten minutes between games.
3. Each team will be given a 5-minute warm-up period before each game.
4. Halftime will be 5 minutes.
5. No team will be allowed to press when leading by 15 points or more.
6. Teams will be allowed 3 timeouts (30 seconds) per game.
7. Three point shots are allowed
8. Overtime periods will start with a jump ball and will be 2 minutes long with a stopped clock. If required, the second overtime will start with a jump ball and will be sudden death. Each team will be allowed one timeout in overtime.
9. Tiebreaker: 1. Head-to-head record; 2. Lowest defensive points total.
10. Per the Greater Suburban Basketball Association: 6th and 7th grade teams must employ man-to-man defense. 6th and 7th grade teams are allowed to press but must return to man-to-man once the offensive team penetrates half court. This rule does not preclude the temporary double-teaming of an offensive player in an appropriate frontcourt situation.
11. Any player, coach or fan ejected from a game will be disqualified for the entire tournament.
12. Each team should be prepared to provide one person to assist as needed with the scorebook.
