



Spot shooting contest Rules

1. Contestants need to be a rostered player for one of N.I.G.F.B.A.'s 5th or 6th grade teams. There is a \$ 2.00 fee for participating.
2. You may shoot as often as you like, provided you pay the \$ 2.00 fee each time and you will need to be signed up. You can not shoot continuously; you will have to go to the end of the line.
3. Contestants need to register at the **Tan Court** at any time between
Saturday 12:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.
Sunday 9:15 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
4. There will be unlimited number of players from each 5th & 6th grade team allowed to compete. The staff operating the contest shall have final say as to when the shooting will stop to be completed by the designated times.
5. Each player will have 45 seconds to make as many points as they can.

Scoring:

There will be five spots on the floor

Free Throw line (center) - 2 points

Elbow marks (free throw line lane line intersect) - 2 points

Each of the low blocks - 1 point

6. Player has to shoot from each of the 5 spots at least once
7. Player will start at the free throw line for their first shot
8. Player must shoot at or behind the designated spot. If player steps on or across the line before shooting shot will not count.
9. Players will shoot a regulation women's 28.5 ball. They may bring **One** of their own balls to shoot with or basketballs will be provided to use.
10. In the event of a tie there will be a shoot off between the players involved. The shoot off will consist of the best of 5 shots being taken from the free throw line
11. Players are responsible for being available for tie breakers. Results and tie breakers will take place on the Tan Court on Sunday March 16th 3:00 p.m.
12. The top 3 players from the 5th & 6th grade will shoot off during halftime of the All Star Game
13. The top 3 will need to be at the All Star Ct. (Maroon Ct) @ 6:15 Sunday March 16th to register. It is the responsibility of the participants to check on the standings wall, to know if he/she advanced to the finals the standings will also be posted Saturday night on the web site www.nigfba.com. Each participant needs to check the Sunday scores at the Libertyville Sports Complex
14. There will be awards given out to the champion at each age level
15. All decisions by the judges are final.
